RMHC GWS provides a home-away-from-home to over 1,500 families with seriously sick or injured children each year.

-While McDonald's is our Founding Mission Partner, after their generous support approximately 80% of our operations are unfunded.

-It costs RMHC GWS approx. \$160 to support one family, per night.

-Community support is vital to our ongoing operations, which is why we're calling on your school's support!

Did you know, Ronald McDonald House Charities also supports students through in-house education support by qualified teachers, as well as access to 40 hours of free tuition when the patient returns home.



Fundraising Guidelines

Name and logo use

- Be clear that your fundraiser or event is not being managed by RMHC GWS, but instead is an activity held in "support of Ronald McDonald House Charities Greater Western Sydney".
- Any printed materials or advertisements to be used in relation to the event must be submitted to RMHC GWS for approval.

Permits and Public Liability

- RMHC GWS does not provide public liability insurance for fundraisers. We suggest holding your fundraiser at a venue which is already covered by public liability insurance.
- The fundraiser is responsible for sourcing any permits, licenses, or authorisation from local councils or shopping centres that may be required.

Media and promotion

- Social media is a great way to promote your fundraising event. Don't forget to follow and tag us on social media so we can follow along your fundraising journey (and possibly reshare your fundraiser on our socials).
- All media materials that reference Ronald McDonald House Charities Greater Western Sydney must be approved by RMHC GWS prior to circulation.


